DIY HVAC Filter Change Instructions

Dear Tenant,

To ensure optimal performance of the HVAC system in your unit, please follow the instructions below to change the air filter:

Materials Needed:

- New HVAC air filter (ensure it matches the size and type specified)
- A flathead screwdriver (if needed)
- Gloves (optional)

Instructions:

- 1. Turn off the HVAC system at the thermostat to ensure safety.
- 2. Locate the filter compartment. This is typically found near the air handler or inside the return air vent.
- 3. Remove the access panel using the screwdriver if necessary.
- 4. Take out the old air filter and dispose of it properly.
