Vaccine	Age (Months)
Hepatitis B	Birth, 1-2, 6-18
DTaP (Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis)	2, 4, 6, 15-18
Haemophilus influenzae type b (Hib)	2, 4, 6, 12-15
Polio	2, 4, 6-18
MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella)	12-15
Varicella (Chickenpox)	12-15
Pneumococcal (PCV13)	2, 4, 6, 12-15
Hepatitis A	12-23

1. Why are vaccinations important?

Vaccinations help protect your child from serious diseases and prevent outbreaks in the community.

2. Are vaccines safe?

Yes, vaccines are thoroughly tested for safety and effectiveness before being approved for use.
