

Museum Emergency Preparedness Guidelines

The safety of our visitors, staff, and collections is our top priority. In light of this, we have developed the following emergency preparedness guidelines to ensure a swift and effective response in case of an emergency.

1. Emergency Contact Information

2. Evacuation Procedures

In the event of an emergency requiring evacuation:
